

HOW TO PROTECT YOUR BUSINESS FROM WILDFIRES

BEFORE

- Invest in wildfire-resistant construction
- Maintain your defensible space
- Have a response plan
- Take pictures for insurance
- Determine the most likely direction of a wildfire

DURING

- Monitor local and state info distribution
- Move combustible material away from windows
 - Close all windows, doors, and other openings
 - Remind employees of response procedures

EVACUATION

- Shut off gas and fuel
- Turn off all machinery and equipment
- Make sure your sprinklers work
- Turn off HVAC equipment
- Ensure that ALL employees evacuate

AFTER

- Initiate your business continuity plan
- Determine steps to recover regular operations
- Consider applying for a Physical Disaster Loan or Economic Injury Disaster Loan
